About Simeulue

Simeulue is located 150km off the west coast of Sumatra and is part of the Aceh Province.

Surfing is the main attraction to western travelers. It is only in recent years that tourism has begun to develop on the island. Surf smart travelers have realized that compared to other parts of Indonesia, Simeulue remains far less crowded. Many guests have commented that it reminds them of Bali, prior to over development.

The main town called Sinabang is located about 15 minutes from the airport. There are markets, local stores, traditional coffee shops and warungs lining the streets. There are no major shopping centres, bars or clubs on Simeulue. There is a large hospital located near the town center.

The people of Simeulue are warm and welcoming. The local religion is Sharia Muslim and you will see Mosques in every village you pass through.

Dressing modestly is local custom. Guests should wear t-shirts when riding scooters outside of the resort. Surfing or sunbaking in Bikinis is considered inappropriate and is reserved for boat trips to outer islands.


